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Results concerning manufacturing of tubular car components using hydroforming and hydroperforation processes

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Abstract

The purpose of the paper is to highlight the advantages that the automotive industry gains by using hydroforming and hydroperforation processes in automobile manufacturing. In recent years, progress has been made concerning the equipment and tools needed to carry out the hydroforming and hydroperforation processes.
